

Finding Steering Rack Center

1) Find center by turning the steering wheel all the way to one side to lock and mark the steering wheel with a thin piece of tape at exactly 12:00. Then turn the wheel all the way the other way and mark 12:00 again. Then turn back toward center and half way in between the marks will be center on the rack. Accurately measuring from your tape marks to place a third piece of tap at dead center will assure accuracy of center.

2) Laying a bar across the doors against the steering wheel and clamping steering wheel to it with a squeeze grip on each side of the wheel will lock it on center well enough to perform alignment. Leaving the center mark tape on the steering wheel while aligning will allow you to be sure it didn't move during the process.
